### **Treasurer and Trip Fund Report : Jen Sims**

Account balances:

BancFirst Checking: \$991.70

JPS Activity Fund - General account: \$120,536.98

JPS Activity Fund - Concessions: \$63,642.76

- Oktoberfest check has not been received; when it comes in, the money will be posted to worker's trip fund accounts; Reasor's Pie fundraiser will be posted this week.
- Trip fund accounts can also be used for tuxedos and formal dresses for concert bands.
- Reminder that we maintain the concessions stand for Soccer and LaCrosse in the Spring; and continue for the rest of football season. This is a good way to start building up funds for expenses next year also. If we cannot fully staff the concession stands, other campus organizations would have to be called in, which would decrease our portion of this very profitable fundraiser.

- Indianapolis trip is next Wednesday. Check-in is at 6:00 that morning. If your child takes a prescription medication, it MUST be checked in with Ms. Arnold and Mrs. Davis.
- Band members will place their luggage in the hold area under their bus; and are responsible to ensure that their uniform and hat boxes are packed properly.
- The bus will stop in Joplin, MO for a quick rest stop and new bus drivers.
- Please make sure your child has at least \$10 for lunch on the way back to Tulsa on Sunday.
- Thursday, the band will rehearse, and go to the stadium to watch some of the other bands.

- Friday at 1:30 is our preliminary performance; we will find out at 9:45 that evening if we go on to semi-finals on Saturday. About 30 bands go to semi-finals, then 14 go on to finals.

- There will be souvenir sales (t-shirts, etc.) at the stadium. So plan accordingly. Any cash sent is the sole responsibility of your child. He should keep it on his person or hidden away carefully in luggage at all times.
- **Basic Trip Rules:**
  - Students are not to go anywhere alone.
  - No use of drugs or alcohol; no shoplifting. (Student will be immediately sent home!)
  - Students may not enter other students' hotel rooms. Even chaperones do not enter the students' hotel rooms.
  - Students may not leave their hotel rooms after curfew.
  - Deadline for any pizza deliveries to hotel rooms is 30 minutes before curfew.
  - Students are responsible for damages in their hotel rooms. If a student sees something already damaged in their room upon arrival, please let chaperones know!
  - Be courteous and respectful to everyone! We are representing Jenks High School, Jenks, OK, and Oklahoma. We want to leave a great impression!
  - Public Displays of Affection are prohibited.
  - Comply with JHS school dress code at all times.
  - Be prompt; please be ready to load the bus when it is time to travel.
  - Please be quiet in the hallways and public areas of the hotel, so that we do not disturb others staying there.
  - Please bring one normal-sized suitcase only; a backpack or tote is allowed on the bus for personal objects. You may bring an iPod, personal DVD player, etc; but it should be used with headphones so others are not disturbed. All movies PG-13 or below, please.
  - Stay on assigned bus. There is no switching buses.
  - Keep track of your own belongings at the hotel. The hotel will not be responsible for belongings that go missing.
